

Complement-taking strategies in Kapampangan
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Abstract

This paper is a preliminary study on sentential complementation of Kapampangan, a language of the Central Luzon in the Philippines. Based on elicited data, it describes variations of complement-taking strategies employed in two types of complementation, i.e., complement of a predicate (complement clauses) and complement of a noun (adnominal clauses). It also gives typological implications on complementation.
