

The purpose of the SCOPIC - TUFS 2019 Workshop will be to build on work started at the 2018 Workshop, report on progress made by project members in the past year and support participants in their own annotation in the functional domains of 1) Reported Speech, Thought and Emotion, 2) Stance and Engagement and 3) the connection between Reported Speech and Complement Clauses and their equivalents. Reported Speech, thought and emotion is the direct and indirect speech expressed as a representation of an utterance or thought from another person or of the speaker at another point in time. Stance and Engagement is how interlocutors signal their confidence in the propositions they make, how they became aware of information, and how they navigate the authority of knowledge between themselves.

The workshop days (18-22 March, 10am-4pm) will feature talks on Reported Speech from Seongha Ree (Korean), Yanti (Indonesian), Norikazu Kogura (Sibe), Keita Kurabe (Jinghpaw) and Yukinori Kimoto (Ilokano and Arta), as well as a talk from Desak Eka Pratiwi on Stance in Balinese. Nick Evans and Danielle Barth will give talks on project progress, an introduction to Stance and Engagement and on Reported Speech & Complement Clause Functions. The morning of the first workshop day will be dedicated specifically to Japanese and working with the already partially coded Japanese data. This special session is optional for workshop participants and will be geared to those who will work on Japanese data. Each workshop day will also have blocks of time for workshop participants to annotate their own data, with support from the workshop organizers. We will endeavour to provide technical support with the ELAN software, as well as support with application of the annotation schema. The workshop will also provide the opportunity for workshop participants to provide feedback and engage in discussion about interesting categories and patterns they see in their own data.
